Topic: Word Power

The second lecture of College Faculty Forum was held on 01.12.2021 under the chairmanship of Dr.B.Devika Rani, Principal. Sri E.V.Bhaskara Reddy Lecturer in English gave a power point presentation to the faculty on "Word Power". He began his presentation explaining to the audience that learning a language is learning a skill and one acquires a skill only by doing it, in the sense that one becomes good at a language only by using it in one's day to day life. He, then, turned his attention to the role of vocabulary in the mastery of a language. He said that "Words are the building blocks of a language". It is the words with which we clothe our thoughts, feelings, emotions and ideas. He, then, went on to explain what it means to learn a word. Learning a word involves learning its correct pronunciation, spelling, phrases associated with it, collocations and words that are often confused with it. He illustrated each point with concrete and relatable examples.
