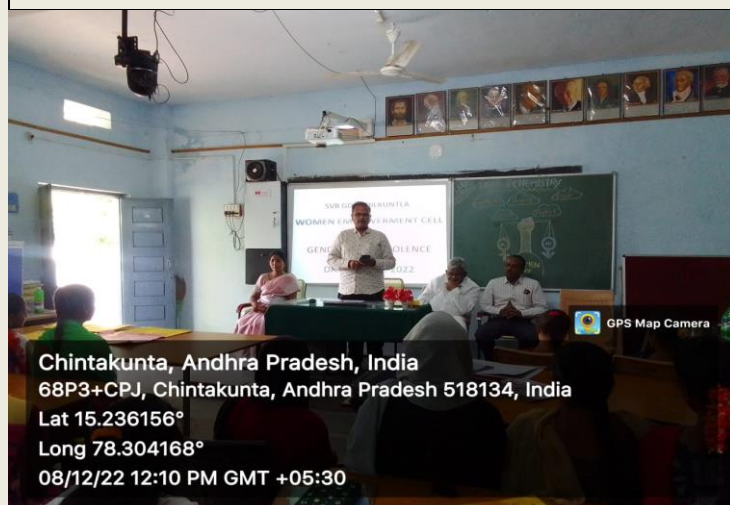


Awareness Programme on Gender Violence

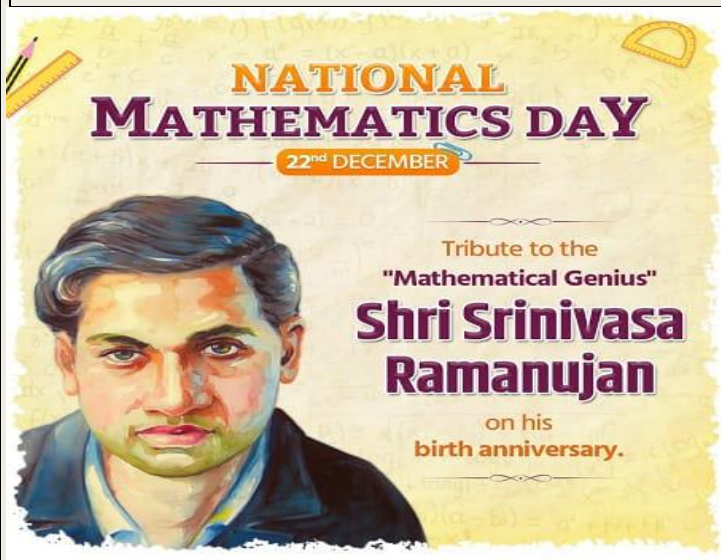

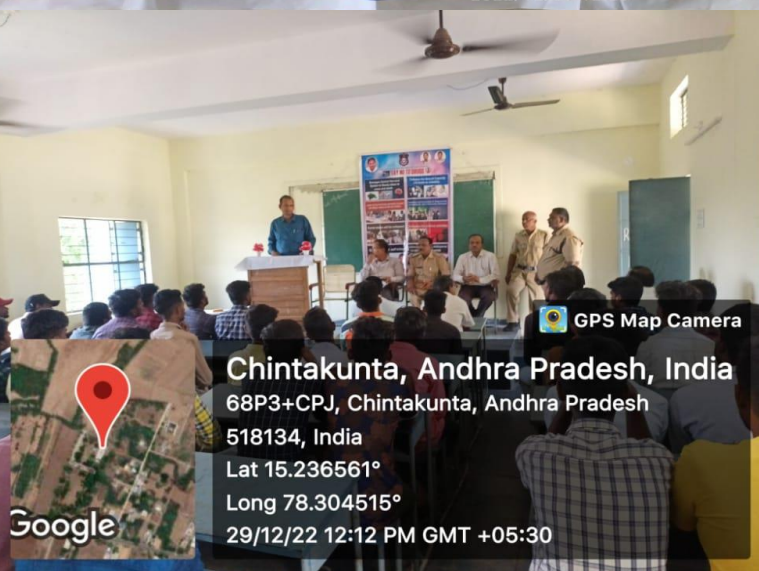


Awareness Programme on Drug Abuse & Prevention
