National Deworming Day

Date: 10.02.2022

Organised by: Dept. of Zoology

The Dept. Of Zoology conducted National Deworming Day on 10.02.2022. Speaking on the occasion, Sri R.Babunath, Vice-Principal said that every student of the college should be aware of the symptoms of the worms inside the stomach and also raise awareness among the general public of preventive measures. Dr.H.Ramasubba Reddy, Coordinator, NAAC, said that worms such as Ascaris, Enterobius, cause Amebiasis, Diarrhoea and Stomach ache. Sri E.V.Bhaskara Reddy, IQAC Coordinator said that many diseases can be prevented by following the rules of hygiene and sanitation. Sri U.Venkateswara Reddy, Lecturer in Commerce suggested that deworming can be done by taking tablets such as Albendazole and Mebendazole once every six months. Later, Albendazole tablets were administered to the staff and to about 200 students, under the supervision of Dr. H.Ramasubba Reddy. Sri Krishna Das, Lecturer in Physics, Sri Siva Nagi Reddy, Lecturer in Physics and other staff participated in the programme.

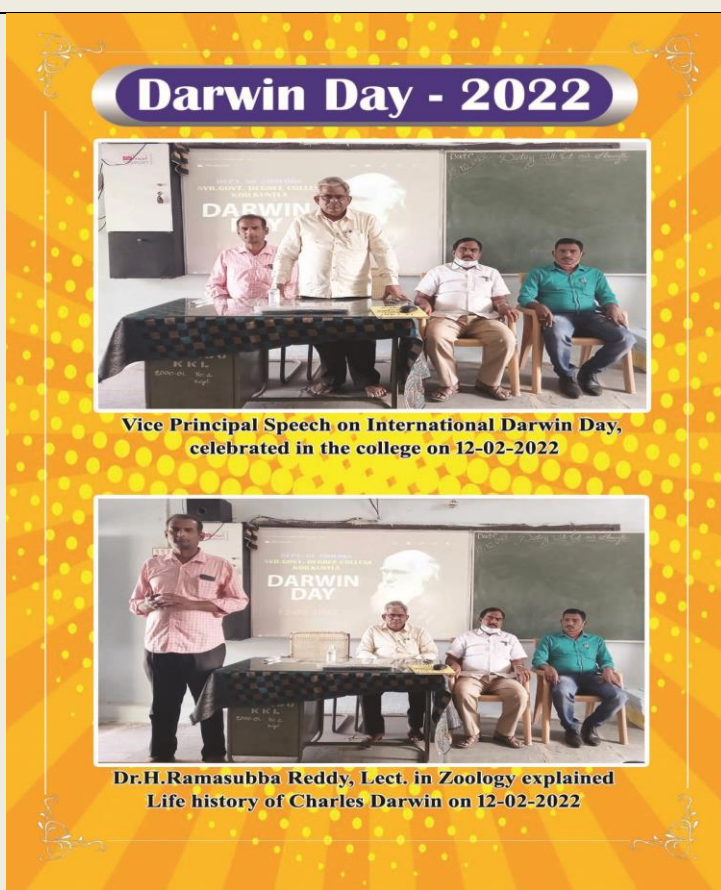
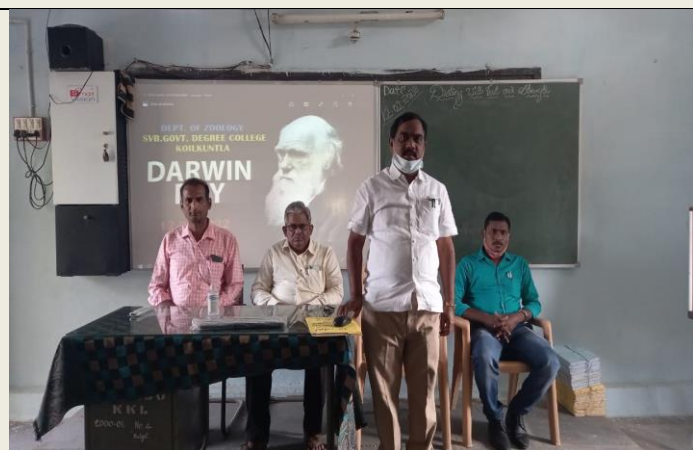
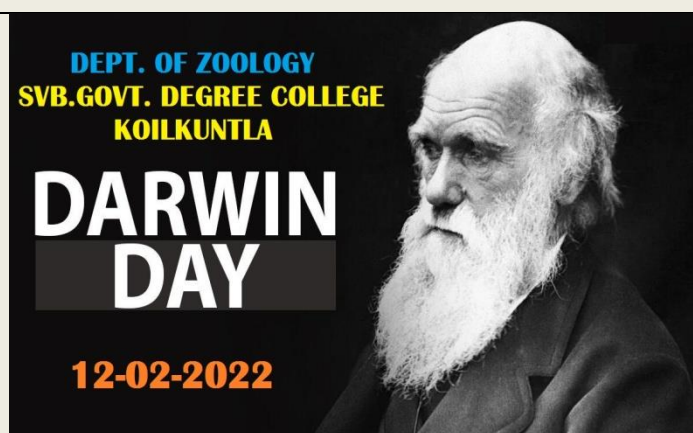
