Degree College was established at Koilkuntla under the aegis of Late Sri Pendekanti Venkata Subbaiah, former Governor of Bihar and Karnataka, in 1981. The main objective was to develop this area educationally. About 85% of students hail from socially disadvantaged communities with low income levels. Conventional and restructured courses are offered in this college. The introduction of all courses is giving a greater opportunity for students of this educationally backward area. The CPDC (College Planning and Development Council) and Alumni are a great source of strength to this college. S.V.B.Govt. Degree College moulds the students as responsible citizens and strives to impart employable skills to them. The college has gone for accreditation by NAAC, Bangalore and got B+ Grade in 2007. It went for reaccreditation in 2015 (Second Cycle) and secured B++ Grade.




International Accounting Day




National Education Day




World Diabetes Day
