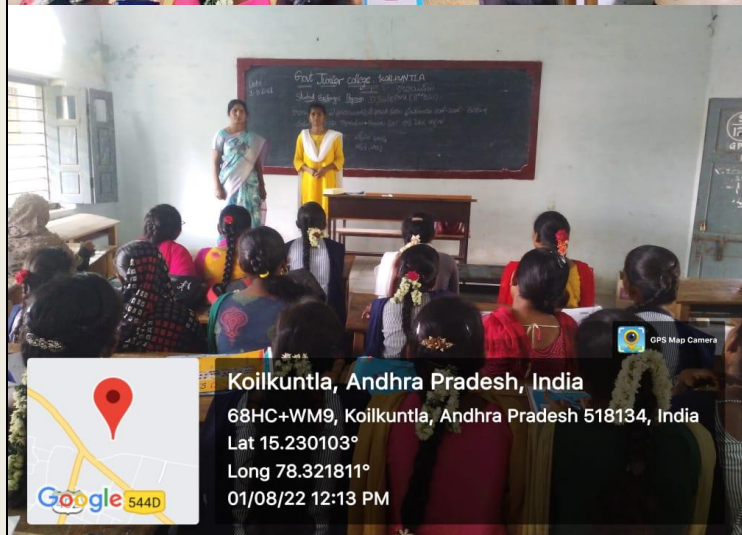

Extension Activity

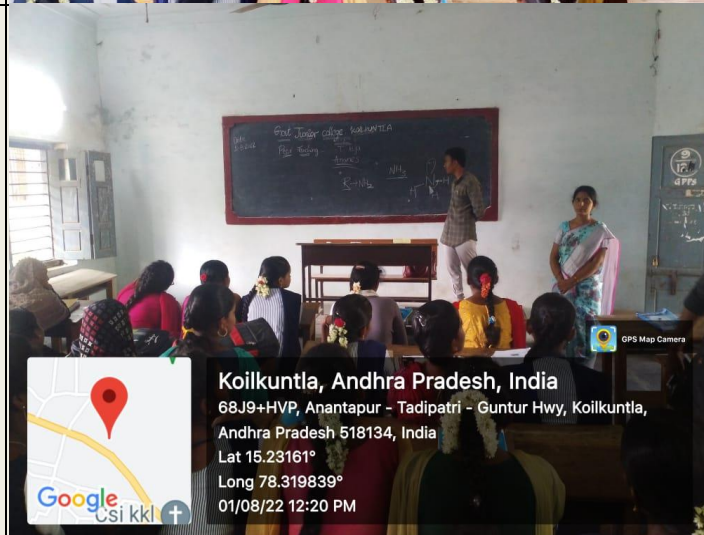
Date: 01.08.2022

Hiroshima Day

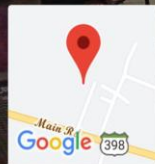

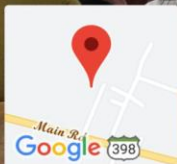

Rama Subba Reddy, Lecturer in Zoology explained to the students how Japan had to undergo great suffering when Nuclear Bombs were dropped on its cities of Hiroshima and Nagasaki. Sri A. Krishna Das, Lecturer in Physics explained to the students that Hiroshima day is observed every year on August 06th to commemorate the atomic bombing of Hiroshima in Japan during the II World war. The bombings killed more than two lakh people in just a few seconds and injured many more.



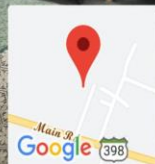
