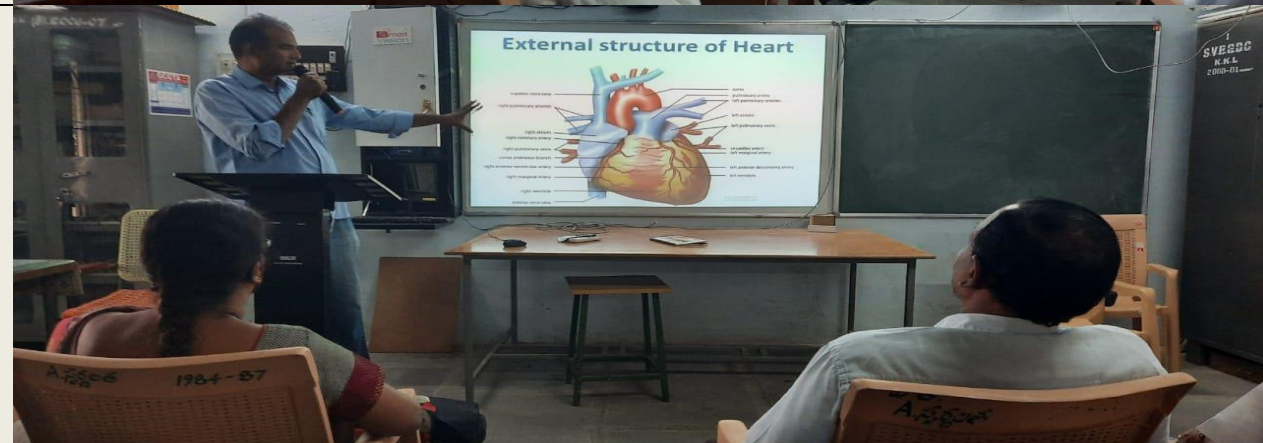

Topic: Heart Diseases - Preventive Measures
